2. The terms of reference of the Committee are as follows:

To monitor the compliance of the provisions of the Notification No. S.O. No. 1545 (F) dated 25th June 2009 (Mount Abu Notification) declaring Mount Abu and surrounding region as an Eco-sensitive Zone published in the Gazette of India Extra-ordinary Part II Section (3) Sub-Section (ii) and discharge the functions specifically enumerated in the notification.

- 3. The Committee or any officer or member of the Monitoring Committee authorized by the Committee shall file complaints under Section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if offences under the said Act come to the notice of the Committee.
- 4. The tenure of the Committee is for a period of two years and can be subsequently extended, if necessary, by the Government of India.

- The expenditure on the Monitoring Committee shall be met by the Government of Rajasthan.
- The Monitoring Committee shall meet at least once in two months and dispose of its business within a period of 90 days.
- The quorum for the Monitoring Committee shall not be less than five members including the Chairman.
- TA/DA for the non-official members shall be met by the Government of Rajasthan as per the State Government rules.
