

S.O.580 .-Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board (Qualifications and other Terms and Conditions of Service of the Chairman and Member Secretary) Rules, 2021.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (e) of sub-section (2) of section 64 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and clause (aa) and (f) of sub-section (2) of section 54 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the State Government, hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board (Qualifications and other Terms and Conditions of Service of the Chairman and Member Secretary) Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- “Act” means the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (Central Act 6 of 1947.);
- “Board” means the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board constituted under the Act;
- “Government” means the Government of Rajasthan; and
- “Chairman” means the Chairman of the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board;
- “Member Secretary” means the Member Secretary of the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board.

3. Selection of the Chairman.- (1) The Chairman of the Board shall be nominated by the State Government on the recommendation of the Search cum Selection Committee. The Search cum Selection Committee shall consist of the following, namely:-

(2) The Search cum Selection Committee shall recommend the name of the selected candidate to the Department of Personnel for issue of order of nomination..

(3) If an officer of the Government is nominated as Chairman of the board, he shall be deemed to be on deputation.

4. Educational and other qualifications for nomination as Chairman.- No person shall be eligible for being nominated as Chairman of the board under clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Act, unless he,-

(a) possesses Post Graduate Degree in science relating to environment or Degree in engineering in a discipline relating to environment from a recognized University or institute and has special knowledge and fifteen years of experience relating to the environment protection including industrial pollution mitigation, water treatment or air pollution control devices and has rendered twenty-five or more years service under the government; or

(b) is or has been a member of All India Services under the service of Central or any State Government in the rank and pay of a Principal Secretary to the Government and above, and has experience in administering institutions dealing with matters related to the environment.

5. Selection of the Member Secretary.- (1) The Member Secretary of the Board shall be appointed by the State Government on the recommendation of the Search cum Selection Committee on deputation. The Search cum Selection Committee shall consist of the following, namely:-

(2) The Search cum Selection Committee shall recommend the name of the selected candidate to the Department of Personnel for issue of order of appointment or order of posting.

6. Educational and other qualifications for appointment as Member Secretary.- No person shall be eligible for being appointed as a Member Secretary of the Board under clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Act, unless he,-

(a) is a member of All India Services in the service of Central or any State Government and holding a post on regular basis in the parent cadre or the department in the pay scale level 13A or higher of the Central Government or its equivalent in State Government, and

(b) Possessing a post graduate degree in science or a degree in Engineering from a recognized university or its equivalent with knowledge and experience related to environment.

7. Age.- The age limit for nomination as a Chairman shall not exceed sixty years of age and for appointment as Member Secretary shall not exceed fifty six years of age, on the last date fixed for the receipt of applications.

8. Tenure.- The term of service of the Chairman and Member Secretary shall be for a period of three years.

9. Salary of the Chairman and Member Secretary.- The Chairman and Member Secretary shall be paid monthly salary and allowances as decided by the State Government, from time to time.

10. Power to relax.- Where the State Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules..

Applications are invited from interested and eligible candidates for appointment to the posts of the Member Secretary, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board (RSPCB), Jaipur.

The RSPCB was established under provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974. The RSPCB exercises functions related to prevention and control of pollution. The Member Secretary shall be a full-time incumbent.

The following are the terms and conditions for the post:-

Essential Qualification and Other Experience	(a) is a member of All India Services under the service of Central or any State Government and holding a post on regular basis in the parent cadre or the department in the pay scale level 13A or higher of the Central Government or its equivalent in State Government, and (b) Possessing a post graduate degree in science or a degree in Engineering from a recognized university or its equivalent with knowledge and experience related to environment.
3.	Age Limit	The age limit for nomination as a Member Secretary shall not exceed fifty six years on the last date fixed for the receipt of applications.
4.	Method of Recruitment	By nomination by the Search cum Selection Committee on Deputation basis or Contract basis.
5.	Pay-Scale	As per the provisions in Rajasthan Service Rules, related to deputation till the attainment of age of superannuation and after attaining the age of superannuation shall be decided by the State Government.
6.	Tenure	The term of service of the Member Secretary shall be for a period of three years.
7.	Terms and Conditions	The Member Secretary shall be governed by the terms and conditions as prescribed in the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board (Qualifications and Other Terms and Conditions) of Service of the Chairman and Member Secretary) Rules, 2021.
