SPECIAL DISPENSATION SCHEME- REGARDING

As per the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution), Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, all industries/ processes/ projects/ activities etc shall obtain prior Consent to Establish and Operate before establishing/ operating any industry/ process/ activity etc. However, there are instances where some of the industry process/ activity etc. are operating without valid Consent to Operate from the State Board. In order to encourage such units to comply with the provisions of the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981, the State Board in the past had introduced special dispensation schemes vide office order nos. F12(56-B)/Policy/Plg/RPCB/6024-55, 1415-48, 1162-1208, 584-628, 987- 1021,195-229, 1263 - 1296, 2276 - 2279, 1687 - 1697, 2172 - 2179 & 1162-1195 dated 22.02.2012, 30.08.2013, 08.03.2018, 14.09.2018, 01.02.2021, 01.07.2021, 03.11.2023, 27.11.2024, 14.02.2025 & 23.08.2025.

In continuation to the effort and to encourage Hotels and other service sector units viz resorts, hospitals, marriage gardens, institutions, shopping malls, automobile servicing stations, call centers, BPOs etc operating without CTO, to apply for consent the State Board has decided to bring in a "Special Dispensation scheme" whereby such units can apply for CTO till 31/03/2026. The applications will be dealt with respect to following conditions:-

- This scheme will be applicable for Hotels and other service sectors entitle (as referred above) operating and which are not at present under the ambit of consent management of the State Board (All fresh applications which have been / shall be filed for the first time shall be entitled under the scheme).
- Such industries will apply for consent to establish as well as consent to operate under the provisions of the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 as per the prevailing procedure/ fee. However, as one-time relaxation, such units will not be required to pay the back-period fees for the years, they have been in operation.
- The scheme will also be applicable on Hotels and other service sector units which have already applied for consent and their applications are pending with the State Board, (irrespective of date of application). In no case the applications which have been earlier disposed by the State board shall be considered for refund of back period fees.


All Group In-charges and Regional Officers are directed to ensure disposal of all consent applications received under this scheme on priority. In any case all such consent applications shall be disposed within 60 days from the receipt of the application in the Board.

This bears approval of the competent authority.
