Issuance of permission for transferring KLD from one industrial unit to other industrial units (which are connected with CETP)"

The Balotara Water Pollution Control Treatment & Research Foundation Trust has represented to the RSPCB regarding modification in order no. F.14(56B)/Policy/Plg/RPCB/733-773 dated 15.07.2020 in the matter of "Issuance of permission for transferring plant & machinery from one industrial unit to other industrial units (which are connected with CETP)".

In supersession of all orders issued related to this matter of transfer of trade effluent (KLD) from one CETP member textile unit to other CETP member textile unit at Pali, Jodhpur, Balotra, Bithuja & Jasol, following will be eligible for transferring trade effluent (KLD) from one industrial unit to other industrial unit:-

- (i) The unit which intends to transfer trade effluent (KLD) should have valid consent to operate from the State Board.
- (ii) The receiving unit should have valid consent to operate/applied for consent to establish form the State Board.
- (iii) The unit which intends to transfer trade effluent (KLD) and the unit to which trade effluent (KLD) is proposed to be transferred (receiving unit) should be valid member unit from CETP Trust for the trade effluent (KLD).
- (iv) The unit should have permission accorded/granted by CETP Trust (SPV) for transfer of trade effluent (KLD) from one unit to another unit duly approved by District Level Monitoring Committee.
- (v) That the trust while issuing permission should consider adequate capacity of waste water carrying pipeline i.e. conveyance system.

The procedure to be followed for grant of consent for transfer of trade effluent (KLD).

- (i) The receiving unit shall apply for consent to establish/consent to operate with adequate fee and requisite details and documents as per check list.
- (ii) The unit should submit permission accorded/granted by CETP Trust (SPV) for transfer of trade effluent (KLD) from one unit to another unit duly approved by District Level Monitoring Committee. That the trust while issuing permission should consider adequate capacity of waste water carrying pipeline i.e. conveyance system.
- (iii) Thumb rule criteria for estimating the discharge of effluent shall be as per the guidelines issued by the State Board.
- (iv) Once transfer of trade effluent (KLD) allowed from one unit to another unit, no further transfer shall be allowed again within 03 years from last transfer to transferring unit and receiving unit.
- (v) The receiving unit shall submit action plant for up-gradation of PETP wherever required.
- (vi) The total of trade effluent (KLD) proposed to be transferred and remaining trade effluent (KLD) with the transferring unit shall not exceed consented trade effluent (KLD) of the State Board.
- (vii) The maximum 50% of existing consented trade effluent (KLD) of transferring unit shall be allowed for transfer from one industrial unit to other industrial unit.

(viii) The project proponent of the unit to which machinery is to be transferred shall submit and undertaking on Rs. 100/- non judicial stamp paper duly notarized with declaration that:-

(a) Due to transfer of trade effluent (KLD) there will be no increase in pollution load at CETP.

(b) I/we not install any new/additional plant & machinery in the unit premises without Board's prior consent.

(c) The unit will not discharge any effluent outside the premises other than the CETP drain within consented capacity and shall comply with the prescribed standards.

(d) I/we will be liable to comply with all consent condition and if any violation of observed then I understand the Board will take action against the unit under the provisions of the Act/Rules.

(ix) The transferring unit shall also apply for consent to operate for changed capacity. The consent so granted shall be subject to the various Orders/Judgments passed by the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), Hon'ble Supreme Court or any other Court of the nation.

This bears approval of the competent authority.
