As per the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the project proponent is required to intimate the State Board regarding any accident or unforeseen act or event of

- a) discharge of poisonous, noxious or polluting matter into a stream or well or sewer or on land under Section 31 of The Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.
- b) emission of any air pollutants into atmosphere in excess of standard to State Board under Section 23 of The Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

RSPCB has developed an online mechanism to make reporting of such event easier and transparent.

Accordingly, all the project proponents are directed to submit above intimations from their login ID using **Utility → Compliance of directions** services
