NOTIFICATION

Jaipur, November 19, 2015

S.O. 165.—In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 6 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 (Act No. 21 of 2012) read with rule 33 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013, the State Government, being of the opinion that mandatory procurement from micro and small enterprises situated in Rajasthan is necessary and, likewise, purchase and price preference in procurement from micro, small and medium enterprises situated in Rajasthan is necessary for the promotion of domestic industry and for furtherance of the socio-economic policy of the State Government, hereby notifies that it shall be mandatory for the procuring entities, as defined in sub-section 2 of section 3 of the said Act, to procure the goods mentioned in Schedule from micro and small enterprises only and, also, to accord price or purchase preference or both to the micro, small and medium enterprises situated in Rajasthan in procurement of the goods not included in Schedule, in the following manner, namely:-

1. For the purpose of this notification,-

- (a) The '**micro**', '**small**' and '**medium**' enterprises means the micro, small and medium enterprises classified under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Micro, Small and Medium

Enterprises Development Act, 2006 and situated in Rajasthan and recognized by the Industries Department as such;

- (b) '**Act**' means Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 (Act No. 21 of 2012);
- (c) '**Form**' means form appended to this notification;
- (d) '**Goods**' means Goods, as defined in the Act;
- (e) '**Government**' means the Government of Rajasthan;
- (f) '**Local enterprise**' means an industrial undertaking or a business concern or any other establishment by whatever name called, engaged in the manufacture or production of goods, in any manner, pertaining to any Industry specified in the first schedule to the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951, situated and have received their acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum and registered in the State of Rajasthan;
- (g) '**Price Preference**' means the mode of evaluating the price bids, specified hereinafter, between local enterprises and enterprises from outside the State, in response to a bid called by any procuring entity, with all other parameters of the bid being the same;
- (h) '**Purchase Preference**' means preference in purchase, for the local enterprises included in the category under clause 1(a) in response to a bid called by any procuring entity, with all other parameters of the bid being the same; and
- (i) '**Schedule**' means schedule appended to this notification.

2. Goods shall be divided into the following two groups:

- (a) Items mentioned in Schedule, which shall be procured entirely from local micro and small enterprises.
- (b) All other items, which can be procured from any other source, subject to clause 4 of this notification.

3. Whenever any Notice Inviting Bid in respect of any item / items mentioned in Schedule is issued,-

- (a) a clause shall be incorporated in the Notice Inviting Bid that the item/items to be procured shall be reserved for

procurement only from the micro and small enterprises situated in Rajasthan, as defined in the clause 1(a) of this notification;

- (b) 4% of such procurement shall be earmarked for procurement from local micro and small enterprises owned by member of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe;
- (c) bids received from sources other than those specified in clause 1(a) shall not be taken into consideration;
- (d) the contract for supply of goods to the enterprises included in the category mentioned at clause 1(a) may be given to the extent of their capacity by breaking the order in part for procurement of goods; and
- (e) representative of the Industries Department shall also be a member of Procurement Committees, constituted under rule 3 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013, whenever the procurement is in respect of item/items mentioned in Schedule of this notification. Such member shall not be below the rank of District Industries Officer. In case, the procurement of goods, above rupees ten lakhs, is being made for item/items not mentioned in Schedule of this notification, then it shall be optional for the procuring entity to invite a representative of the Industries Department, not below the rank of District Industries Officer, as member of the Procurement Committee.

4. For items not included in Schedule, price preference shall be given to local enterprises in comparison to bids received from enterprises outside the State, by evaluating the prices quoted as follows:

- (a) while tabulating the bids of local enterprises, the element of Rajasthan Value Added Tax shall be excluded from the rates quoted by these enterprises, whereas the element of Central Tax shall be included in the rates of enterprises from outside Rajasthan for evaluation purpose only, provided that the specifications and all other requirements are in accordance with the bid.

- (b) in case, the prices of the local bids are not found competitive even after grant of price preference, and the bidding enterprise from outside the State is adjudged lowest, then purchase preference to local enterprises shall be given in the following manner, subject to fulfillment of all required specifications and conditions of the bid:-
- (i) opportunity shall be given to local enterprises to supply 80% of the Bid quantity (with 20% order to be given to the original lowest bid enterprise). Out of this 80%, minimum of 60% would be required to be purchased from the local micro & small enterprises, in case they have also bid, and within this 60%, 4% shall be earmarked for procurement from local micro and small enterprises owned by member of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe. The remaining quantity, out of the above mentioned 80% and to the maximum limit of 20%, shall be procured from the local medium enterprises in case they have also bid.
 - (ii) to exercise this option of Purchase Preference for 80% of the bid quantity, in such a situation, a counter offer would be given to the local enterprise, which has quoted the minimum rate among the local bidder enterprises, to match the overall lowest (L1) rate received. In such case, price preference stated in clause (a) above shall no longer be applicable and net lowest price (L1 price) would be required to be matched.
 - (iii) in case, the lowest local enterprise does not agree to the counter offer as per sub clause (ii) above, or does not have the capacity to provide the entire bid quantity, the same counter offer shall be made to the next lowest bidder of the eligible local bidder enterprises, in that order till the quantity to be supplied is met. The contract for supply of goods to

the enterprises included in the category as mentioned at clause 1(a) may be given to the extent of their capacity by breaking the order in part for procurement of goods, in the manner provided in rule 74 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013.

(iv) in case, a bidder offering to supply the goods is a dealer located in Rajasthan and the bid prices are equal to the rates offered by local enterprises of Rajasthan and the quality and specifications of the goods are the same, the local enterprises shall be given Purchase Preference over such dealer.

5. It shall be mandatory for the procuring entity to record reasons in writing in all cases where items manufactured by local enterprises of Rajasthan are not procured and Purchase Preference is not given as provided in this notification, which, interalia, would be in the case of either non participation in the bidding process by local enterprises of the State or inability by local enterprise to match the lowest bid price offered by out of State Enterprise or not matching the required specification to the Bid by the local enterprise.
6. The powers to grant Purchase Preference or Price preference or both shall be exercised by an officer or procuring entity to the extent they have been delegated powers for procurement of Goods in the Schedule of powers under General Finance and Accounts Rules or other general or special order applicable to particular department, Public Sector Undertaking/ Autonomous Body etc.
7. The data of procurement from micro, small & medium enterprises is vital for strengthening the policy and for this purpose, every procuring entity shall include procurement to be met from micro, small & medium enterprises in their respective procurement plan and achievement made, thereto, in their respective Annual Reports.

8. To reduce transaction cost of doing business for micro, small and medium enterprises of the State, having acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum as mentioned in Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, issued by the competent authority shall be facilitated, on furnishing of a self-attested copy of acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum, as follows, or as amended in the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013:-
 - (a) bidding document shall be provided to the micro, small and medium enterprises at 50% of the prescribed cost;
 - (b) bid security for the micro, small and medium enterprises shall be @0.5% (half percent) of the value of the quantity offered to be supplied by them; and
 - (c) performance security for the micro, small and medium enterprises shall be @1% of the amount of quantity ordered for supply of goods.
9. (a) Two copies of Notice Inviting Bids issued for the procurement of goods included in Schedule shall invariably be sent to the office of Commissioner of Industries, Rajasthan, which shall arrange it to upload on the website of the Department of Industries and to send it further to General Managers of all District Industries Centers of the State;
- (b) For the goods other than those included in Schedule, wherever in the opinion of the procuring entity, micro & small enterprises are likely to bid against a particular notice inviting bid, two copies of each such notice inviting bid shall be sent to the Commissioner of Industries for uploading it on the website of Department of Industries.
10. In order to seek price preference or purchase preference or both under this notification, an application, as prescribed at Form A, shall be submitted by the local enterprise to the General Manager, District Industries Centre of the district

concerned, or to the officer nominated by Industries Department, who, after due diligent examination, shall issue verification certificate for the same:

Provided that, in case of any grievance in this regard, an appeal on plain paper may be filed by the aggrieved applicant to the Commissioner, Industries Department or to an officer nominated by him for the purpose.

11. Every micro, small and medium enterprise shall be required to submit an affidavit, in Form B, along with the duly filled bid document, to the procuring entity.
12. Before issue of the work order to the micro, small or medium enterprise, as the case may be, for the requisite procurement, the procuring entity may approach the appropriate authority under Industries Department, not below the rank of District Industries Officer, in order to ensure that the said enterprise, from which the procurement is to be made, possesses necessary production capacity in quantitative and qualitative terms, as required in the bidding document. The Department of Industries, in such case, shall provide the required support to the procuring entity concerned.
13. The following Monitoring Committee shall monitor the implementation of this notification and removal of difficulties, including grievances made by micro, small and medium enterprises, namely:-
 - (i) Principal Secretary, Industries (SSI&KVI) Chairman
 - (ii) Commissioner of Industries, Rajasthan Member
 - (iii) Director, MSMED Institute, Government of India, 22 Godown, Jaipur. Member
 - (iv) Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Rajasthan, Jaipur or his nominee not below the rank of Superintending Engineer. Member
 - (v) Chief Engineer, PWD, Rajasthan, Jaipur or his nominee not below the rank of Superintending Engineer. Member

- (vi) Chief Engineer PHED, Rajasthan, Jaipur Member or his nominee not below the rank of Superintending Engineer.
- (vii) Financial Advisor, Department of Member Industries, as representative of Finance Department.
- (viii) Additional/Joint/Deputy Director, Industries Convener (Marketing)
