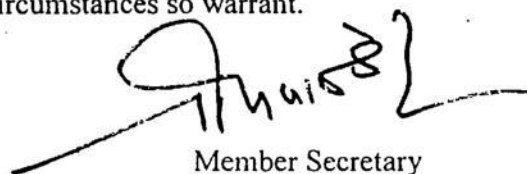

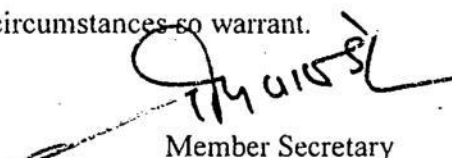

All those industries/ projects/ processes/ activities/ mines, which are not covered under Red or Orange category and are discharging waste water and/ or air emissions will be covered under Green category

Notes:

1. For the small/ tiny scale industries, which are covered under Green category and are discharging waste water and/ or air emissions which do not require any treatment to conform the discharge/ emission standards prescribed by the State Board, the acknowledgement of the receipt of the complete application by the State Board shall serve the purpose of grant of consent for the period of remittance of notified consent fees and till such time that the unit modifies/ changes its process. Provided that the State Board, may conduct random checks or call for information from any small scale unit and make a formal consent order prescribing condition (s) etc., as required.
2. The classification of industries in large/ medium/ small/ tiny scale shall be as notified by the Industry Department.
3. The State Board may revise this list as and when the circumstances so warrant.

OFFICE ORDER

Delegation of powers to Regional Officer

In supersession to all earlier orders/ circulars/ guidelines, the competent authority for grant or refuse of the Consent to Establish/ Operate under the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974/ Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under the Bio-medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 shall be Regional Officers of the State Board for industries/ projects/ processes/ activities/ mines located within their territorial jurisdiction as follows:-

- All industries/ projects/ processes/ activities covered under Green category;
- All industries/ projects/ processes/ activities covered under Orange category, except the following:
 - Hotel, Motel, Resort > 50 beds
 - Hotel, Motel, Resort located in water body or within 200 Mtrs of High Flood Level (HFL) of water body.
- All industries/ projects/ processes/ activities/ mines under Red category with restrictions noted appropriately below:

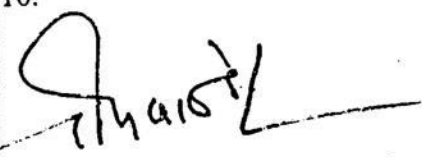
1	Mining/ quarrying of minerals in area < 5 Ha except in case of Scheduled major minerals.
2	Small and tiny scale mineral grinding units except asbestos units.
3	Small and tiny scale phosphate rock processing plant.
4	Small and tiny scale bone grinding units.
5	Small and tiny scale glue and gelatin units.
6	Small and tiny scale units for manufacturing of paper from waste paper and ready pulp except in cases involving bleaching.
7	Small and tiny scale units for formulation of pesticides, agro chemical and so on.
8	Small and tiny scale lubricating oils, greases or petroleum based products units.
9	Small and tiny scale drug formulations except bulk drugs and intermediates units.
10	Formulation units of ink, pigments and intermediates.
11	Small and tiny scale units of chemicals, electro chemicals including acids, and so on except those covered under MSIHC Rules 1989.
12	Small and tiny scale units of chlorates, per-chlorates, and peroxides except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
13	Small and tiny scale units of chlorine, fluorine, bromine, iodine, and their compounds except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
14	Small and tiny scale units of industrial carbon including electrodes and graphite blocks, activated carbon, carbon black, and so on except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
15	Small and tiny scale units of industrial or inorganic gases namely (A- Chemical gases such as acetylene, hydrogen, chlorine, fluorine, ammonia, sulphur dioxide, ethylene, hydrogen sulphide, nitrogen, oxygen, phosphine and so on, B- Hydrocarbon gases such as methane, butane, ethane, propane and so on except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
16	Small and tiny scale units of phosphorous and its compounds except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
17	Small and tiny scale units of synthetic detergent and soap except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.

18	Small and tiny scale units of synthetic resins except those covered under MSIHC Rules, 1989.
19	Potable alcohol bottling plant.
20	Foundries, induction/arc furnaces/ cupola furnaces/ other furnaces < 5 tons per heat (TPH).
21	Building and construction projects < 5000 sq. Mts. but ≥ 2500 sq. Mts. of built up area or dwelling unit ≥ 50 but < 100 units.
22	Health care establishments, nursing homes and hospitals < 100 beds.
23	Small and tiny scale industry or process involving electroplating operations.
24	Small and tiny scale anodizing units.
25	Small and tiny scale automobiles manufacturing/ assembly units.
26	Small and tiny scale industry or processes involving metal treatment or process such as pickling, paint stripping, heat treatment, phosphating or finishing, and so on.
27	Non mechanized slaughter houses, meat processing and cold storage plant.
28	Small and tiny scale ceramic/ refractory units.
29	Small and tiny scale explosives, fire crackers and allied units.
30	Small and tiny scale milk processing, dairy products and allied units.
31	Small and tiny scale soft drink, mineral water and allied units.
32	Small and tiny scale food, vegetable, fruits processing units including confectionery units.
33	Small and tiny scale vegetable (refinery, extraction) oil processing, hydrogenation and allied units.
34	Small and tiny scale wool scouring units.
35	Glass and fiber glass production and processing units other than molding.
36	Parboiled rice mill.
37	Lime/hydrated lime manufacturing.
38	Brick kiln.
39	Dimensional stone cutting and polishing except marble, granite and Kota stone.

Note-

1. The consent applications of all the industry/ project/ process/ activity/ mine etc. covered under EIA Notification, 2006 and Arava Notification, 1992 shall be dealt at RSPCB Head Office irrespective of the delegation of power noted above.
2. The classification of industries in large/ medium/ small/ tiny scale shall be as notified by the Industry Department.
3. In case any application is refused at the Regional Office level, the decision on the application submitted subsequently by the applicant shall be taken by at RSPCB, Head Office level. Besides, if the applicant had paid fee for more than one year, the fee in excess of one year shall be returned to the applicant on refusal of application. The fresh application shall be considered with fees as per the notification number G.S.R. 73 dated 10.12.2010.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
