## Sub: Vision Plan for reduction of NPA

The matter regarding reduction of NPA was dwelled at length during the review of Branch Offices held recently. It was observed that the achievements of the Corporation for 2007-08 were satisfactory and all time high. But still quite a lot is required to be done for reduction of NPAs. Needless to say that reduction in NPAs is of paramount importance and would lead to better health of the Corporation and bring significant improvement in the quality portfolio of the Corporation.

It has, therefore been decided to approach this issue systematically and to ensure that the NPAs are brought down to the level of 5% or less in the next 2 years. For Ajmer, Kishangarh, Bikaner, Jaipur (City), Jaipur (VKIA), Balotra and Rajsamand, the targets have been fixed on the basis of reduction of NPA to the level of 0.5%.

A vision plan has been drawn to reduce the level of NPAs and for this purpose, targets have been fixed for each Branch Office for 8 quarters beginning from 1.4.2008 to 31.3.2010. The details of quarter-wise targets allotted and the amount upto which the NPA is aimed to be reduced is given in the enclosed Annexure.

Branch Offices would reduce NPA by 40% in first and second quarter and 20% in the third quarter. Shortfall, if any, in the first three quarters would be made up in the fourth quarter of the year for which no targets have been given. However, it will have to be ensured that the targets allotted are achieved in full during the financial year 2008-09 and 2009-10.

Detailed strategy for reduction of NPA has already been issued. It is enjoined upon all concerned that they should make all adequate efforts in this regard may be done to achieve the targets assigned so as to

fulfill the objective of reduction in NPAs at the level of 5% in next twoyears.

All concerned are advised to take a note of above for strict compliance.
