

REVENUE (GROUP VIII) DEPARTMENT NOTIFICATION

Jaipur, October 9, 1975.

S. O. 526:—As the Population of prohibited Wild Life species of Gharial (*Gavialis Gangeticus*) and Crocodile (*Crocodilus plaustries*) has dwindled considerably almost to the point of extinction, the Government considers necessary to take steps to protect, propagate and develop the above species along with other natural fauna. The Kota Dam (Jawaharsagar) reservoir on river Chambal and surrounding forests have adequate ecological, faunal, floral, geomorphological natural environment and some population of above wild life species.

Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under section 18 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 the Government declares the area of this reservoir and surrounding forests, having boundary description as given below as Jawahar Sagar Wild Life Sanctuary. It will come into force from the date of publication in the Rajasthan Gazette.

Description of Boundaries.

- North:—Kota Dam (Jawahar Sagar) and Road from Kota Dam to Borabas.
- East:—Road from Borabas to Rawatbhata (Rana Pratap Sagar) Dam.
- South:—Rawatbhata (Rana Pratap Sagar) Dam and Road from Rawatbhata Dam to Dundesra and Lotiana.
- West:—Western Boundary of notified Forest Blocks Ambarani, Guda Rajpura, Bhunjar, Padajhar, Primagra and Road from Masera Ghata to Lotiana.
