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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1. The Government of Rajasthan (GOR) has received a loan from Asian Development Bank (ADB) for the implementation of water supply and sewerage systems in selected district towns in the state under the Rajasthan Urban Sector Development Program (RUSDP). RUSDP will complement the past and ongoing efforts of the GOR to improve water supply and wastewater services to the residents of the state of Rajasthan. It comprises (i) a program, financed by a policy-based loan of US \$250 million, to support policy reforms, including institutional development and governance improvement in the urban sector in the state, and (ii) a project, financed by a project loan of US\$ 250 million (project cost 360 million including state share of US\$ 110 million), to invest in water distribution network and sewerage systems in the six project cities in the state. The six project cities were selected based on consideration of the cities' lack of basic services and their willingness to undertake reforms and institutional restructuring.
- 2. Apart from this, ADB has also approved a grant of USD 2 million from Bill and Melinda Gates Foundations (BMGF) fund as part of RUSDP, which would help the state to pilot innovative sanitation solutions (in two Towns) in non sewer areas of the state. The pilot testing is aimed at demonstrating the feasibility of septage management options, On-site sanitation options, including low cost and environment-friendly toilets, and decentralized treatment. The pilot testing will also look into regulatory and institutional arrangements, particularly from sustainability perspectives. The Outcome of the pilot envisaged is improved delivery in Rajasthan. Under the project Government of Rajasthan decided to execute the septage management in three small towns(Sambhar & Phulera², Lalsot and Khandela).
- 3. The Local Self Government Department (LSGD), GoR is the Executing Agency (EA) of the project, and responsible for overall strategic approvals, guidance, monitoring the execution of the project. Program Management Unit (PMU), headed by Project Director and assisted by experienced officers from engineer and finance services are responsible for the implementation of the project. Social Project Officer (SPO) at PMU assisted by Resettlement Expert(RE) of Project Management, Design, and Supervision Consultants (PMDSC) is responsible for the implementation of social safeguards related activities. Besides, an Assistant Safeguard Officer (ASO), PMDSC, has been mobilized in each project town for implementation of the project³.
- **4.** The current report is the 8th semi-annual social safeguard monitoring report prepared for the reporting period from **July 2019 to December 2019**.
- 5. Six draft resettlement plans(RPs) were prepared for the selected six project cities/towns during the loan processing stage. All six RPs prepared during the loan processing stage were to

be revised⁴ during implementation by PMDSC. Accordingly, a resettlement framework (RF) was also prepared to guide RUSDP on Involuntary Resettlement (IR) impacts during project implementation. As agreed, a new RP was also to be prepared by PMDSC for the Bulk water scheme of Pali Town.

- 6. Social impact assessment(SIA) of proposed FSTP sites in all the towns(Sambhar & Phulera, Lalsot and Khandela) funded by BMGF has already been done. Field visits (conducted by a team including PIU, Consultant and staff of urban local body, revealed that vacant government lands are available in the three towns where Feacal Sludge Treatment plant (FSTP) works will be constructed. Due Diligence Reports (DDRs) of all the three sub-project as per ADB safeguard policy statement (SPS 2009) are prepared and will be submitted to ADB.
- 7. To date, all the six draft RPs have been revised. In addition to this, one new RP is prepared for additional package identified for the Bulk water scheme i.e. RUSDP/Pali/02⁵. The agreed RPs are being implemented (except Tonk and Hanumangarh⁶) based on a detailed measurement survey.
- 8. It is to confirm that all subprojects do not cause (i) any significant involuntary resettlement (IR) impacts or/ and (ii) impact on indigenous people. The IR impacts envisaged on squatters and mobile vendors operating in right of way(RoW) are temporary and mainly resulting from disruption of livelihood during the construction period, and Affected Persons (APs) are being paid compensation as per the agreed entitlement matrix. The advance information regarding the upcoming construction activities to ensure no or minimal disruption in their livelihood also communicated to all stakeholders. The assistance to temporarily shift to the other side of the road, where no civil work is proposed, will also be provided so that economic and livelihood activities are continued.
- 9. All the contracts are on design built operator (DBO) modality, project implementation unit (PIU) & PMDSC are monitoring the works closely, and due diligence is being done for the additional works and changes occurring in the original scope during finalization of Service Improvement Plan (SIP)⁷. During this reporting period, three RPs (Pali, Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar) were revised. The changes reported are summarized as below:-
 - ➤ During SIP finalization, locations of sewerage pumping station(SwPS) have changed in Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar and location for SwPS were finalized in the Pali town subproject.

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Since all the RPs were based on transect walks data in key representative areas and visual screening of 60- 70 percent of the roads/areas was extrapolated for results and budget preparation. The following six resettlement plans were prepared during the loan processing stage: Pali water supply and sewerage sub-project, Tonk water supply and sewerage sub-project, Sri Ganganagar water supply and sewerage sub-project, Bhilwara sewerage sub-project and Hanumangarh water supply and sewerage sub-project

Reassessment of works that to be executed as per technical specification. SIP is a part of contract.

- ➤ Length of water supply and sewer pipeline was changed in all the three packages (Pali, Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar) and locations for Consumer Relation Management Centre (CRMC), Master Control Centre (MCC), and Central Control Centre (CCC) are finalized.
- 10. The documentary evidence and findings of due diligence are provided in the updated RPs. It is to confirm that no land acquisition is involved under these packages. The identified/changed lands are government lands, and the work of SwPS and other buildings CRMC/CCC/MCC was allowed only after completion of necessary inter-departmental transfers. The length of the proposed water supply and sewerage network has changed, as during SIP contractors have rearranged the alignment and eliminated areas, where there was no habitation and few residential areas, have been included which were left out during the preliminary report (within municipal boundary) in the scope to provide the basic utilities to maximum households.
- 11. This is to confirm that, as per the due diligence conducted, the project is still classified as category "B" for IR as there is no land acquisition under the sub-projects and no additional APs were identified⁸.
- 12. Up to this reporting period, all the contracts have been awarded and physical works are under progress in all the project towns (Pali, Sri Ganganagar, Jhunjhunu, Bhilwara) except Tonk and Hanumangarh. Contract of FSSM works of the three sub-project has also awarded⁹ and physical works almost completed. Under FSSM works, Feacal Sludge Treatment plant (FSTP) constructed in the vacant government land and plant will be operated shortly. As per scope of works, State Feacal Sludge Septage Management (FSSM) Policy, and State FSSM Guidelines also prepared, which has been approved from RUDIP and DLB, and submitted to LSGD.
- 13. By the end of the reporting period, the resettlement assistance of Rs 37.60 lacs has been paid to 538 APs, while 112 APs have shown their unwillingness, and 92 APs are under the missing category. 23 APs under Pali-2 package which were missing in last reporting period, have now identified during gap-filling and hydro-testing works. Out of 23, the payment has been disbursed to eight APs, and payment of three APs are under process, while the impact on 12 APs has been avoided.
- 14. Among the 112 unwilling APs, 27 in Jhunjhunu sub-project and 4 in Pali-2 sub-project have shown their willingness for taking payment after continue persuasion. Since the payment is yet to be credited, the unwilling APs have been reported as 112. Till the end of this reporting period, impacts on 674 APs were avoided (mainly due to alignment change/ night work/trenchless work), and no impact on common property resources (CPRs) in the working areas has been reported.

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During preparation of draft RP, anticipating the possibilities of minor changes in scope, SIA and socio economic survey was conducted for the entire town and potential APs on both side of the roads were already included in the RP. Hence no changes were reported due to change of alignment.

- 15. The implementation of RP for the Pali Bulk water supply package has been completed 10. The RP is being updated and will be submitted to ADB for final approval after documentation of implementation records. The details of the final impacts are under the package are as below:
 - > As per the draft RP, 292 potential APs in 10 areas were identified, and the same was intimated to the contractor for necessary planning.
 - > Later during SIP, due to technical requirements, two new potential areas were notified to the implementation team by the contractor. Since the survey of the entire town was already available with the implementation unit, a re-confirmation of impact was conducted and work was allowed under the package. Accordingly, after SIP, total nos of APs was increased to 312 under the package.
 - During implementation, the impact on 143 APs was avoided, as some of the areas were deleted from the subproject scope. While in some areas, the water supply pipeline was laid only on one side of the road, as such, the impact on 92 APs was also mitigated. 16 APs are reported to be missing while 6 APs have shown an unwillingness to accept compensation.
 - > Payment has been disbursed to 42 APs and micro plans and other details of 13 APs are submitted for payment.
- The various orientation program with project contractors, project implementation unit(PIU) 16. and PMDSC site staff were held in all the project towns on safeguard issues. The City Level Committee (CLC), acting as a grievance redress committee (GRC) has been established for each town, chaired by the District Collector. GRC registers are in place at the towns. PIUs with support of Community Awareness and Participation Consultants (CAPC) & contractors are entrusted with the responsibility to maintain a proper grievance register and ensure that the grievances received during execution are recorded and resolved within the specified timeframe. During the reporting period, minor complaints from the people (housekeeping, pipeline damaged, leakages in a new connection. etc.) were received. which have been resolved satisfactorily. No complaints/grievances related to social safeguards were received during the reporting period.
- Internal monitoring of RP implementation was done by PIU and RE of PMDSC. Assessment of impact as per final alignment was done and a method to avoid impact was conveyed to the contractors. During internal monitoring of Pali Bulk water supply scheme, it was noticed that the execution of work along the National Highway at chainage 111.500 to 111.55 near Panihari circle one persons has claimed that water supply pipeline is being laid through his proprietary land having boundary walls on two sides and not along the right of way belonging to National Highway Authority of India(NHAI). The matter was taken up with the NHAI and District Administration, Pali who have confirmed that land belongs to NHAI and not to claimant. The work

Since, no land acquisition was involved in the project and only temporary impacts were identified during laying of tramission pipelines, the implementation of package is considered to be completed as all the pipelines are layed and no pipelaying work is pending. All the proposed new structures are complete and only rehabilitation work of OHSRs are under progress.

was undertaken without impacting the boundary walls as such there was no need to compensate the affected person.

18. A series of meetings and consultations with APs and other stakeholders were done in the respective towns including the areas where FSTP works are going on. Project-related issues, and its advantage was discussed. The consultations were was also done with those APs who have voluntarily inclined not to receive the compensation despite being offered. Monthly visits and interactions were done, as a result, few of them finally agreed/ assured for submission of documents for payment. ADB mission visited project towns and interacted with communities and APs and feedback taken from them. Orientation program organized in core unit for sensitized safeguard issues to newly appointed officials of implementation unit.

A.1 **Project Components**

3. The primary objective of the RUSDP is to promote sustainable growth and poverty reduction in the six selected cities of Rajasthan. The Project is financing infrastructural development, in the form of construction and rehabilitation, related to water supply and wastewater inclusive of capacity building of existing Municipal Corporations. Social and community development is forming an important component of the project, involving community mobilization; under well-organized proactive public awareness campaigns. The works proposed for six selected towns, along with details of the contractor and physical progress is provided in **Table 1**.

B. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 4. The purpose of the semiannual social monitoring report (SMR) is to analyze periodically over the total implementation period of the project to comply with the approved involuntary resettlement (IR) documents such as resettlement plans (RP) and due diligence reports (DDR).
- 5. RUIDP has the responsibility to oversee the implementation and monitoring of social safeguards issues of each subproject in the project towns. This report covers resettlement and social safeguard monitoring results to comply with the spirit of ADB policy to 'enhance stakeholders trust' and ability to engage with ADB, and thereby increase the development impact (of projects) in which disclosure of safeguard monitoring is a prominent aspect. This report covers social monitoring, addressing all the issues related to social safeguards, with reference to the progress achieved and the current status of the reporting period.
- 6. This consolidated report outlines monitoring the implementation of social safeguard activities, from **July to December 2019**, in accordance with the ADB Safeguard Policy (SPS), 2009.

C. SOCIAL SAFEGUARD CATEGORIZATION

7. The construction of the sub-project does not require any acquisition of land or cause permanent displacement. The locations for the permanent site (sewerage treatment plants, water treatment plants, sewerage pumping stations, pumping stations, raw water reservoir, etc.) have been carefully selected and proposed in the vacant encumbrance free government land and the pipes for water supply, and sewerage will be laid within road rights-of-way (RoW). Only temporary impacts are anticipated in the project as the laying of pipes may cause temporary access disruptions and possible temporary losses in income to non-titled businesses operating on movable/transitory structures (pushcarts) in the RoW. **Details are provided in Annexure 1.**

8. The Project has been classified as **category "B"** for involuntary resettlement (IR) and **"C"** for Indigenous Peoples (IP) as per the ADB's SPS, 2009.

D. STATUS OF PREPARATION/ UPDATING OF RP

- 19. Six draft resettlement plans(RPs) were prepared for the six project cities/towns during the loan processing stage. Further, all the six RPs were to be revised¹³ during implementation by Project Management, Design, and Supervision Consultant (PMDSC). Accordingly, a resettlement framework (RF) was also prepared to guide RUIDP on IR impacts during project implementation. As agreed, a new RP was also to be prepared by PMDSC for Pali Town. Social impact assessment(SIA) of proposed Feacal Sludge Treatment plant (FSTP) sites in all the towns(Sambhar & Phulera, Lalsot and Khandela) funded by BMGF has already been done. Field visits (conducted by a team including PIU, Consultant and staff of urban local body, revealed that vacant government lands are available in the three towns where Feacal FSTP works will be constructed. Due Diligence Reports (DDRs) of all the three sub-project as per ADB safeguard policy statement (SPS 2009) are prepared and will be submitted to ADB.
- 9. On the basis of the detailed measurement survey, the RPs revised/updated. Six RPs were revised and one new RP was prepared for additional package identified f^or Bulk water scheme i.e., RUSDP/Pali/02)^{14.}
- 10. Being a Design-Build Operate contract, even though consultants prepare the detailed project reports (DPRs), the final design/alignment was to be provided/ re-confirmed by the contractor. During the preparation of revised RPs, the vendors on both sides of the road were considered as affected persons (APs) to avoid complications. Further, to facilitate RP implementation, a Zone/DMA wise list of APs identified during Social Impact As^sessment (SIA) with 100% socio-economic details were provided to contractors for freezing of alignment and for avoiding/ confirming the impacts on APs.
- 11. During this reporting period, RPs of Pali, Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar were revised due to a change of subproject scope, alignment and location of the civil components. The changes reported are summarized as below:-
 - ➤ During service improvement plan(SIP) finalization, locations of SwPS Pumping stations have changed in Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar as per technical requirement and location for SwPS were finalized in the Pali town sub-project.
 - ➤ Length of water supply and sewer pipeline was changed in all the three packages (Pali, Jhunjhunu, and Ganganagar) and locations for Consumer Relation

Management Centre (CRMC), Master Control Centre (MCC), and Central Control Centre (CCC) are finalized.

- 12. The documentary evidence and findings of due diligence are provided in the updated RPs. It is to confirm that no land acquisition is involved under these packages. The identified/changed lands are government lands, and the work of SwPS and other buildings CRMC/CCC/MCC was allowed only after completion of necessary inter-departmental transfers. The length of the proposed water supply and sewerage network has changed, as during SIP contractors have re-arranged the alignment and eliminated areas, where there was no habitation and few residential areas, have been included which were left out during the preliminary report (within municipal boundary) in the scope to provide the basic utilities to maximum households. (Ref Annexure 2 for further details). As per due diligence, there is no addition to the APs and subproject are still under "B "category. RPs of all three packages have been submitted to ADB for review.
- 13 The implementation of RP for the Pali Bulk water supply package (Pali-2 package) has been completed 15. The RP is being updated and will be submitted to ADB for final approval after documentation of implementation records. The details of the final impacts are under the package are as below:(a) As per the draft RP, 292 potential APs in 10 areas were identified, and the same was intimated to the contractor for necessary planning.(b) Later during SIP, due to technical requirements, two new potential areas were notified to the implementation team by the contractor. Since the survey of the entire town was already available with the project implementation unit(PIU), a re-confirmation of impact was conducted and work was allowed under the package. Accordingly, after SIP, total nos of APs was increased to 312 under the package.(c) During implementation, the impact on 143 APs was avoided, as some of the areas were deleted from the subproject scope. While in some areas, the water supply pipeline was laid only on one side of the road, as such, the impact on 92 APs was also mitigated. 16 APs are reported to be missing while 6 APs have shown an unwillingness to accept compensation.(d) Payment has been disbursed to 42 APs and micro plans and other details of 13 APs are submitted for payment. (Refer Annexure 3 for further details).

E. IMPLEMENTATION OF RESETTLEMENT PLAN

14. The methodology followed for implementation of RPs is as following: Prior to the start of work, contractors provide the advance work plan to PIU & PMDSC along with the final alignment. After the intimation by the contractor, the joint re-confirmatory survey is conducted by the officials of PIU, PMDSC, and contractor to finalize the list of APs likely to be impacted due to civil works. Since at the time of preparation of RPs, the exact alignment was not known, the RP contained the details of all the business establishments likely to be impacted. While finalizing the alignment, efforts are being made to avoid the impacts, and

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Since, no land acquisition was involved in the project and only temporary impacts were identified during laying of tramission pipelines, the implementation of package is considered to be completed as all the pipelines are layed and no pipelaying work is pending. All the proposed new structures are complete and only rehabilitation work of OHSRs are under progress.

accordingly, the APs present in this section are included in the mitigated list. During this reporting period, the impacts were avoided in some areas in all the running projects. (**Ref Table 5**)

- 15. The area where the mitigation of impacts on livelihood is not possible, all the APs are re-validated/ verified by the implementing officer (ASO, PMDSC), and ID cards are disbursed to potential AP. During the re-validation, it has been observed that APs listed in the RPs are not available at the site during all the phases: (i) Re-verification; (ii) distribution of compensation; and (iii) construction phase. Since they were not present during the execution of works and did not suffer any impact are being treated as "missing," and confirmation of their absence is being obtained from the other affected HHs. Some of the APs are voluntarily inclined not to receive the compensation despite being offered. These APs are treated as "Unwilling" and their consent is taken in writing. (Refer para 1 Missing and Unwilling APs for further details)
- 16. Once the list is finalized, ASO collects the details required from APs, which include the bank details and other necessary documentation required for the transfer of compensation. Based on findings, the ASOs prepare the micro plans, and after approval/sanction by PIU, these micro plans are submitted to the treasury with required bank details for direct transfer of the compensation in the bank account of APs through electronic clearance service/National Electronic Fund Transfer (RTGS) payment.
- 17. APs are being compensated in accordance with the agreed entitlement matrix of RF. APs are being compensated for 14 days disturbance as per RF, however, micro plans prepared for the project area, takes care of the real impacts on APs and it is ensured that all the APs are compensated for the actual period of disturbance. If the duration of impact is more, they will be compensated for the actual period of disturbance after due verification from PIU. The compensation recommended in the micro plan considers the entitlements prescribed in the RP (livelihood assistance, shifting assistance, and vulnerability assistance), the time lags (7% inflation in survey income is provided per year) of implementation & survey along with additional compensation with respect to minimum wage rates.

1. Missing APs and Unwilling APs

- 18. Some of the temporarily affected APs/businesses in project towns are seasonal and/or migratory in nature. Some of these APs though surveyed are not located or traced during verification, disbursement of livelihood assistance, and construction time. Some APs are also showing their unwillingness to accept assistance. RF of RUSDP is clear on these two issues and it has been clearly agreed with ADB that APs under temporary impacts not traceable for more than 36 months after the start of compensation disbursement, or do not claim their entitlement within project construction period, will bear no impacts of the project and hence will not be considered for compensation.
- 19. In support of missing APs, the implementation officer (ASO) will document written information from surrounding vendors and shopkeepers. It is also decided that confirmation will also be taken from nearby vendors/residents about APs showing unwillingness to accept

R&R assistance. For AP showing unwillingness, along with this certificate, an audio/video recording (if possible) will be documented. For deceased AP, it is decided to make payment to dependents of the deceased AP, and similarly, the payment could be made to guardians of minor APs/ dependents.

20. During this reporting period, it was observed that during backfilling and interconnection works under pall bulk water supply sub-project, few APs being seasonal vendors were missing during the pipe-laying work has come back to the work location. Impact assessment was done before backfilling and inter-connection work, and those impacted were paid.

2. Impact on Community Property Resources (CPRs)

21. During the social impact assessment, it was found that few common property resources(CPRs) (like Water Hut, Community Toilet, Temple, Mosque, etc) are adjacent to the RoW, a list of these adjacent CPRs was prepared and circulated to the contractor for finalization of alignment accordingly. This is to confirm that as per final alignment and survey, no impact is envisaged on any of the CPRs; however, instructions are issued to the contractor (through Employer Representative) for taking adequate care and ensuring strict adherence to safety norms at the time of civil works near CPRs site. Up to this reporting period, no impact on CPRs has been reported.

F. CURRENT STATUS OF RP – IMPLEMENTATION

- 22. Up to this reporting period, all the contracts have been awarded and physical works are under progress in all the project towns (Pali, Sri Ganganagar, Jhunjhunu, Bhilwara) except Tonk and Hanumangarh. The contract of Tonk Water supply and Sewerage subproject has been terminated on dated 26.06.2019 due to poor performance, while the physical works of Hanumangarh Water supply and Sewerage subproject have been stopped due to litigation. Contract of FSSM works of the three sub-project has also awarded and physical works almost completed. Under FSSM works, Feacal Sludge Treatment plant (FSTP) constructed in the vacant government land and plant will be operated shortly. As per scope of works, State Feacal Sludge Septage Management (FSSM) Policy, and State FSSM Guidelines also prepared, which has been approved from RUDIP and DLB, and submitted to LSGD. (Ref Annexure 4 for further details)
- 23. By the end of the reporting period, the resettlement assistance of Rs 37.60 lacs has been paid to 538 APs, while 112 AP have shown their unwillingness, and 92 APs are under the missing category. 23 APs under Pali-2 package which were reported missing, have now identified during gap-filling and hydro-testing works. Out of 23, the payment has been disbursed to eight APs, and payment of three APs are under process, while the impact on 12 APs has been avoided.

- 24. Among the 112 unwilling APs, 27 in Jhunjhunu and 4 in Pali-2 have shown their willingness for taking payment after continue persuasion. Since the payment is yet to be credited, the unwilling APs have been reported as 112 which will change after payment.
- 25. The compensation was paid to affected persons as per approved micro plan which includes, livelihood assistance, shifting assistance, vulnerability assistance, and additional assistance (for the time lag, to maintain minimum wage level. For missing and unwilling displaced persons, records of written information from surrounding vendors or shopkeepers have been collected. The subproject wise detail of payment of compensation along with the numbers of APs is provided in **Table 4**. Details of compensation disbursed during this reporting period are attached in **Annexure 5**, and details of unwilling and missing APs are attached in **Annexure 6 &7**. The subproject wise number of APs are enclose provided in **Table 2**.

Project Impacts Minimization

- 26. Meticulous planning by PMDSC and good practices adopted by the contractor has resulted in mitigation of impact on APs. The good practices adopted by the contractor are as below (including but not limited to following):-
 - Sewer pipelines were laid in the middle of the road, and works were executed in the night with proper safety measures.
 - Worked was executed on one segment at the time on one side of the road, and access was made available for the roadside petty businesses. Excavation has been expedited, and walkways have been provided for access in order to avoid livelihood losses.
- 27. During the preparation of the RPs, the people carrying on business activities on both sides of the road have been considered as APs. In a few patches, the laying of pipelines was done only on one side by the contractor and accordingly no impact was sustained by vendors operating on the other side of the road. All these APs have been considered as mitigated and reported in the SMR.
- 28. Up to this reporting period, impact on 674 nos of APs was mitigated (278 APs in Tonk, 137 APs in Pali/01, 92 APs in Pali 02 Package, 49 APs in Ganganagar, 88 APs in Jhunjhunu) and 30 APs in Bhilwara. Assistant Safeguard officers posted at towns are conducting regular due diligence of work execution and documenting the confirmation taken from the mitigated APs. (**Refer Annexure 8 for further details**). 6 APs(under Pali 1 package) reported mitigated in last reporting period will be impacted for gap filling works confirmed during site visit. Thus figure has been reduced from 143 to 137.

F.1 Orientation Program with Project Contractors /Social Outreach Team PIU and PMDSC Site Engineers.

29. As a part of the implementation strategy, during this reporting period, Orientation programs with project contractors, social outreach teams, PIU, and PMDSC site engineers were held in all the project towns, and safeguard issues were deliberated in detail. The participants were oriented about the following issues: (i) to avoid the impact on livelihood by

maintaining access to commercial establishments as well as residential houses; (ii) work should be executed in a planned/ phased manner so that temporary inconvenience is avoided; (iii) access to CPRs to be maintained;(iv) natural drains should not be disturbed (as far as possible) (v) the alignment pass through the commercial areas, where the road width is sufficient, contractor was advised not to close the road or divert the traffic and the work should be executed on convenient hours / non-peak hours after required consultations with the shop owners/ vendors; (vi) the work should be carried out in patches/phases so that the indirect impact is avoided; (vii) the work in busy and crowded area should be taken during the night to avoid the impact and inconvenience to the public; and (viii) contractor should provide the advance notice should be provided to the public about the work in general and night work in particular.

F.2 Internal Monitoring by PMDSC

- 30. Internal monitoring of RP done by the RE of PMDSC and Safeguard Support of PMDSC, Jaipur. Monthly visit of RE was done in the project towns for access project inputs and the number of persons/families affected and compensated and to confirm that their former standard of living is re-established. A series of meetings and consultations with APs, and other stakeholders were done in the respective towns and project-related issues and its advantage were discussed. It was noticed during site visit that APs were provided advance information regarding the upcoming construction activities to ensure no or minimum disruption in their livelihood. The contact number of concerned staff of PIU, PMDSC, CAPC, and Contractor displaying in the site for lodging complain. Frequent interaction and consultation done with the identified APs who shown their unwillingness to receive any types of assistance. Interaction with those APs to nearby APs (have been compensated) done for share their views/opinions. Views of unwilling APs was captured. Meeting with PIU and PMDSC engineers was also and safeguard issues (freezing of alignment in APs areas, payment of willing APs etc) discussed. (Ref Annexure 9). ADB mission visited project towns and interacted with communities and APs and feedback taken from them.
- 31. Internal monitoring of RP implementation was done by PIU and RE of PMDSC. Assessment of impact as per final alignment was done and a method to avoid impact was conveyed to the contractors. During internal monitoring of Pali Bulk water supply scheme, it was noticed that the execution of work along the National Highway at chainage 111.500 to 111.55 near Panihari circle one persons has claimed that water supply pipeline is being laid through his proprietary land having boundary walls on two sides and not along the right of way belonging to National Highway Authority of India(NHAI). The matter was taken up with the NHAI and District Administration, Pali who have confirmed that land belongs to NHAI and not to claimant. The work was undertaken without impacting the boundary walls as such there was no need to compensate the affected person. The photographs confirming no impact are provides as **an Annexure 9(a)**

F.3 Safeguard Training and Workshops at site office and Core Unit

- 32. PMDSC Core team including RE sensitized all the support engineers of PMDSC and Contractor on safeguard issues. In the training program following topics were discussed in detail: a. ADB Safeguard Policy b. Best Practices while implementing safeguard measures c. Grievance Redressal Mechanism d. Compensation Procedure etc.
- 33. Workshops also organized at the nodal headquarters at Jaipur for newly appointed officials of PIU/PMU to discuss all cross cutting issues like standardization, tendering, social and environmental safeguards etc.(**Ref Annexure 9(b)**

G. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND CONSULTATION

- 34. A series of meetings and consultations with APs and other stakeholders were conducted by the ASO of PMDSC. The issues regarding the scope of the project, entitlement options, impacts, etc. at different stretches during RP implementation. During implementation, PMDSC is conducting public consultation meetings focussing on R&R implementation activities/ procedures which includes discussion on opening of bank a/c and modalities of disbursement of assistance. PIU/ Contractor has been informed that 30 days advance notice is to be provided to APs before civil works are initiated (in that section) and disbursement should be completed prior to the start of civil work by contractor. Information also continues to be disseminated to APs and beneficiaries through various media. (Ref Annexure 10)
- 35. Meeting and consultation also done with stakeholders in FSTP works are going on.Project scope and its advanges was discussed in details(**Ref Annexure 10(a)**.
- 36. To oversee the entire information dissemination and for creating required public awareness, CAPC consultant has been mobilized (in RUIDP PH III) and a separate Social Expert cum Gender Specialist has been deputed in all project town by CAPC.

H. GRIEVANCE REDRESS MECHANISM




Figure 1: Grievance Redress Mechanism

- 37. To ensure that the grievances of the APs are heard and resolved in a timely manner, the grievance redress mechanism (GRM) has been established for the project, which has the following approach and procedure (Figure 1):
- (i) In case the AP has any complaint or grievance, he/she is free to lodge his/her complaint to site engineers of Contractor/PMDSC/PIU, safeguard staff who will make efforts to resolve the complaint on the ground level itself. The project implementation unit will make efforts to redress the grievance within three days from the receipt of the grievance.
- (ii) In case the AP's grievance is not redressed at PIU level, the matter will be put up at PMU level who will ensure that grievance is redressed with the time frame of seven days.

- (iii) If the grievance is not redressed at PMU level within the time frame, the matter will be put up at Grievance Redress Committee (GRC) established in each town, which will address the grievance within fifteen days.
- (iv) APs are free to approach the court of law at any time on their own will and expenses.
- 38. Besides the GRM of the project, the state has an online grievance monitoring system known as Rajasthan Sampark Portal. The APs can also lodge their complaints online at http://sampark.rajasthan.gov.in/index.aspx.
- 39. A toll-free number has also displayed by the contractor in a different location for lodge the grievances.

(a) Information to the APs about the GRM

40. The APs will be informed about the GRM under the project through public consultations, disclosures, and distribution of project information leaflet. The APs will also be informed that in case they are not satisfied with the decision of the GRC, or failing the redressal of grievance; they can take their case/grievances to the judiciary.

(b) Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC)

41. City Level Committee (CLC) is acting as a grievance redress committee (GRC) has been established (Order no F6(45)AR/Gr-3/99 dated 13.09.2013) with the primary objective of providing a mechanism to mediate conflict and disputes concerning compensation payments and cut down on lengthy litigation. GRC consists of following members: District Collector(Chairman) with representatives from the ULB, state government agencies, PIU, community-based organizations (CBOs) and NGOs. As a GRC, the CLC meets at regular intervals based on the availability of the CLC /GRC members and also as per requirement or pending issues.

c) Record-keeping

42. PIUs, Contractor, and CAPC have been entrusted with the responsibility to maintain a proper register of the grievance (if any) which will be endorsed by all agencies involved in implementation. GRC registers are in place at the towns.

(d) Costs

43. All costs involved in resolving the complaints (meetings, consultations, communication, and reporting/information dissemination) will be borne by the concerned PIU

at town level while costs related to escalated grievances will be met by the PMU. Cost estimates for grievance redress are included in resettlement cost estimates.

44. No complaints/grievances related to social safeguards were received during the reporting period.

I. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENT

- 45. An institutional arrangement has been set-up at the project level to ensure that sub-projects comply with ADB's safeguard requirement. The institutional arrangement includes augmenting the capacity of project management & implementation staffs with regard to the smooth implementation of safeguard concerns at sub-project location. The Local Self Government Department (LSGD) is the executing agency responsible for overall technical supervision and execution of all subprojects funded under the program. The Implementing Agency is the PMU of the on-going RUIDP, to coordinate the construction of subprojects and ensure consistency across the towns Project Implementation Unit (PIU) has been established.
- 46. At PMU level, there is a Social Project Officer (SPO), who looks into social safeguard issues, assisted by a Resettlement Expert of PMDSC. The Resettlement Expert is responsible for (i) update the existing RPs based on the detailed design; (ii) assist in the monitoring and supervision of ongoing subprojects and RP and IPP implementation; (iii) prepare RPs for new subprojects, where required to comply with national law and/or ADB procedure; (iv) ensure all subprojects meet safeguard requirements as agreed in the loan covenant and in line with this RF; (v) review and finalize all reports in consultation with the

PMU SPO (RP updating and preparation, preparation of semi-annual social safeguard monitoring report for PMU submission to ADB, and support GRM implementation).

- 47. At each PIU, one engineer has been designated as nodal officer and one engineer from PMDSC site office appointed as a coordinator is responsible for day to day monitoring of envioranmental management plan(EMP) and implementation of RP. Nodal officers of PIU are assisting PMU SPO in implementation of the social safeguards at the PIU level. The PIUs are responsible for the implementation of the RPs. PIUs will undertake internal monitoring and supervision and record observations throughout the project period to ensure that the safeguards and mitigation measures are provided as intended.
- 48. For monitoring of the implementation of RPs, an additional Safeguard Staff / Assistant Safeguard Officer (ASO) for each project town has been appointed by PMDSC, are working under the supervision and guidance of PMDSC Resettlement Expert. The task of ASO assigned is as follows:
 - ➤ To communicate closely with identified (identified through census survey conducted for RP¹7) potential APs / APs)and provide them timely information of construction schedule, distribute identification cards, educate them on their entitlements under the RP and RF, shifting APs/APs during civil work execution inappropriate manner without hampering their income or assets;
 - Assist displaced persons (APs)/ in ;(i) In opening bank accounts (if not already available with APs/APs), disbursement of compensation livelihood losses and resettlement assistance (as per provisions of RF) and ensure that APs/APs obtain their full entitlements under the RPs.(ii) Organize consultation and discussion meetings with the APs/APs, the community leaders and other stakeholders throughout RP preparation and implementation phases. (iii) To organize consultation and discussion meetings with the APs/APs, the community and other stakeholders throughout RP implementation phases with proper documentation. (iv)Ensure disbursement of compensation against livelihood losses, resettlement assistance (vulnerable assistance, shifting assistance, structure losses assistance, crops/trees losses assistance) as per entitlement matrix. (v) Disclosure of RP, Cut of Date in vernacular language at public places & project affected persons and preparation of internal RP implementation monitoring reports. (vi) Distribution of one-month advance notice, to in affected areas that on the following date the civil works will be started in following areas and timely shifting of Squatters and Encroachers from temporary impact zone during construction if required. ;(vii) Registering grievances of APs/APs (the grievance redress mechanism (GRM) already established) and assist to PIU in resolving grievances at PIU level or GRM level. (viii) Assist the APs/APs in the redress of grievances through the Grievance Redress mechanism established as

part of the RP, and make the APs/APs aware of GRM at several levels. (ix) Assist APs/APs in getting benefits from various government development programs particularly for income restoration/ generation,

- 49. M/s IPE Global Pvt Ltd in association with Cogent Training Research Development consultant has been appointed as Community Awareness and Participation Consultants (CAPC) to oversee the entire information dissemination, required for creating public awareness. CAPC consultant has been mobilized on **1 December 2015** and a social expert cum gender specialist has been deputed by CAPC in each project town. Social Development Expert of CAPC is acting as a "Town in charge" for all the community awareness and participation programs and is overseeing the performance of Social outreach team (SOT)¹⁸ of the contractor.
- 50. Social Outreach Team(SOT) has been mobilized in each town for supporting the additional Safeguard Staff and CAPC in implementation of RP and community awareness activities.

J. Conclusion

- 51. The contracts for all the subprojects have been signed, and works are going for all the packages, except Tonk and Hunamangarh, and are under different stages of implementation. The contractors of Pali (both the packages), Ganganagar, Tonk, Jhunjhunu have started works in the APs areas after the required implementation of RP. By the end of the reporting period, the compensation has been disbursed to 538 APs, while 112APs have shown their unwillingness and 92 APs are under missing. The impact on 674 APs have been mitigated and no impact on CPRs like a garden, hand pumps; public water tanks is reported until this reporting period.
- 52. All affected persons are compensated and paid resettlement assistance prior to start of civil works in accordance with the agreed RP.
- 53. The compensation distribution system and grievances handling process have been informed to APs regularly. The information regarding the projects activities has been regularly disseminated to APs and other stakeholders through various media (Meetings, Interactions, Visits, etc.).
- 54. No safeguard compliance issues are left out or un-noticed during this reporting period.
